APPLICATION FOR MULAMULA SATELLITE POLICE STATION TO BE FULL FLEDGED SATELLITE POLICE STATION AND THE SMALL MAGISTRATE OFFICE NEXT TO IT.

1. Dumela Royal Council under Mulamula Tribal Authority in Thulamela Municipality in Vhembe District is hereby making an application in relation to the above issue mentioned.
2. The above mentioned Satellite falls under the jurisdiction of Malamulele Police Station and is servicing many villages for almost 8 hours in five days of which the crime in this area supersedes its capacity whereby most of the time back up from Malamulele Police Station has to be always assisting in the daily operation for effective service delivery.
3. Dumela Royal Council has deemed it fit that the above mentioned Satellite be given the status of working 24 hours and be up graded to accommodate all these villages without compromise as most crimes are reported and attended late because of the capacity of this Satellite as it does not have resources to service its jurisdiction.

It has got 13 villages which rely on them of which if it can be made full fledged Satellite it would ensure that all these villages to follow are given the best service delivery in terms of Batho Pele Principles as cornerstone of government in power. The villages which are given partial service by this Satellite are as follows: Phaphazela, Mkhomi, Gumbani, Hasani-Dakari, Hasani, Machele, Bokoro, Mdabula, Xihosana, Mulamula, Muswani, Nhombelani and Dumela.
5. Should the Government consider this application it will be in the best interests of community members of all these areas mentioned for socio-economic benefits as well as to reduce crime and to expedient sentencing together with reducing unemployment which is rife in this area which is too rural.
